

Bowie Green Citizen Award

The Bowie Green Citizen Award recognizes individuals, schools, or groups that contribute to making Bowie a greener and more sustainable community through innovative practices, educational programs, and community leadership. This award was established to reward members of the community who have actively promoted green living practices in the city and encouraged others to do likewise. Achievements may be focused on green practices in the home, educational activities in the community, and/or actions to promote green policies and practices by community and municipal organizations. Potential actions may involve caring for our natural resource base (air, water, and mineral), protecting habitat diversity, promoting sustainable energy and economic activity, and building thriving neighborhoods in the process.

The award ceremony will be held at the annual Bowie Green Expo in April.

Eligibility

- Nominations are open to individuals, schools, or groups located within the incorporated limits of the City of Bowie.
- Previous award winners may not be nominated.
- Nominations may be made by either the nominee or another party.
- Green Team and Environmental Advisory Committee members, City Officials, and City employees are not eligible to be nominated and judges of the award are not eligible to nominate.

- Selection committee will include members of the Bowie Green Team Executive Committee, Environmental Advisory Committee, and selected citizens.
- Considerations will be given to the following:
 - Estimated positive impact of achievements,
 - Documentation presented to quantify or demonstrate the impact,
 - Breadth of the economic and social impact of achievements,
 - How recent achievements are,
 - Innovation and originality of achievements,
 - Leadership and outreach demonstrated.
