Status Report

1. Stream and Community Clean-up Results

Neighborhood Traffic Management Program Beaverdale Lane

Dear Resident or Stakeholder:

The Public Works Department provided a recommendation for the installation of three speed humps on Beaverdale Lane in response to a request made in accordance with the City's Neighborhood Traffic Management Program. The recommended hump installations were presented at a stakeholders meeting on February 27, 2019. Subsequent to that presentation, a petition was completed as required by City policy. Thirty residents signed the petition in favor of the speed humps which demonstrated the required community support to proceed with this speed hump installation project.

The speed humps will be installed within the next 45 days under a contract with Image Asphalt. The work will result in minor traffic disruptions only.

Also in the near future, the City's Public Works crews will be performing various street pavement repairs on Beaverdale Lane. These street repairs are not related to the installation of the speed humps.
