## SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On March 13<sup>Th</sup>, 2012 at approximately 1415 hours, Bowie Police were dispatched to the 17100 block of Longleaf Drive for a report of subject armed with an ax. Upon arrival, Officers canvassed the area and met with the reporting person whom provided information on the suspect. According to the reporting person, the suspect, who also resides in the 17100 block of Longleaf Drive, smashed a couple of selected mailboxes, made several derogatory racial comments and threats to residents of the community on Longleaf Drive, then retreated back into her residence with an ax in hand. Officers made verbal contact with the suspect thru an open second story window. After 25 minutes of conversing with the suspect, Officers made a successful apprehension without further incident. The weapon was recovered and placed into evidence. The suspect was transported to Prince George's County Hospital and served with an Emergency Petition Service. The suspect was charged by Criminal Summons with destruction of property and hate crime. Homeland Security and Prince George's County NED was notified of the reported hate crime.
