SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On March 6, 2012 at approximately 1554 hours, Bowie Police responded to the 13800 block of Urbana Lane for a hit and run with injuries. The arrested, a 15 year old female, had taken her mothers van without her knowledge and crashed into the victim's vehicle on Urbana Lane at a high rate of speed. The victim was attempting to turn onto Church Road from Urbana Lane, when the striking vehicle turned onto Urbana Lane from Church Road and struck the victim on the driver's side door. The impact caused the airbags from both vehicles to be deployed and pushed the victim's vehicle, a 2002 Chevrolet Tahoe, off of the roadway. The arrested then fled the scene of the accident by driving away. The arrested had fled to her home, where she was found and taken into custody without incident. Both the victim and the arrested were transported to the Bowie Health Center to be treated for minor injuries.
