**The City of Bowie Reminds Residents to Report Potholes**

BOWIE, Md. (March 12, 2015) – The City of Bowie reminds residents that they can report potholes on local roads by going to [www.cityofbowie.org/potholes](http://www.cityofbowie.org/potholes) or by contacting the agency that maintains the road where the pothole is located.

The Streets Division takes care of potholes on all City-owned and maintained streets. To report a pothole on a Bowie street, please complete the City of Bowie Service Request Form or call 301-809-2344 for assistance. There are also links on that page ([www.cityofbowie.org/potholes](http://www.cityofbowie.org/potholes)) to report potholes on roads maintained by Prince George's County and the State of Maryland. Potholes can also be reported to Prince George's County by calling 311 and to the State Highway Administration by calling 301-952-0555 (for numbered roads such as Route 50, 214, 197, 3, and 301).

Potholes are an unsightly nuisance to the everyday commute in the City of Bowie and throughout Prince George's County. Deep potholes can cause serious damage to your vehicle and maneuvering to avoid potholes presents even more dangers to drivers. It is much easier to repair a pothole when it is small and not too deep. Please help the City, County, and the State of Maryland stay on top of the problem by reporting potholes when you encounter them.
