## SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On April 20, 2012 at 1352 hours Bowie units were dispatched for the report of a possible suicide attempt on the Route 50 overpass. Upon arrival, a male subject was seen standing on top of the fence canopy that covers the overpass. The male looked distraught and was sobbing. Parts of the westbound lanes of traffic on Route 50 were closed down for safety reasons. A Maryland State Trooper and Pfc. White of the Bowie Police Department climbed up onto the top of the overpass as well and made contact with the man. They were able to calm him down and safely subdue him until a fire truck ladder could bring them down. MSP took custody of the individual and transported him for a psychiatric evaluation.
