INCIDENT: Driving Under Influence

LOCATION: 13000 Block 6th Street - Bowie MD 20720

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On June 4th, 2015, Bowie Police Officers were conducting an investigation on a critical incident in the 13000 block of 6th Street in Bowie, Maryland. While on scene, a vehicle with a sole occupant, struck a parked City of Bowie Police cruiser, then ran through the crime scene barrier and nearly struck several Officers on scene of the critical incident. The vehicle finally came to a stop and the driver was ordered out of the vehicle. The driver was noticeably intoxicated and was asked to perform in a series of Standardize Field Sobriety Tests (SFST). The driver failed the SFST and after being provided her rights, she agreed to submit to a breathalyzer test. The driver was placed under arrest and transported to District II, Prince George's County Police Department. The results of the breathalyzer showed that she had a blood alcohol level of .13; which is more than the legal limit. The driver was charged accordingly. No one was injured as a result of the accident. This incident was not related to the critical incident that was being investigated at the time.
