SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On 9/3/15 at approximately 2125hrs, Bowie Units responded to the 14000 block of Dahlia Drive, for the report of a burglary in progress. Upon arrival, Bowie Officers spoke with the Victim, who stated that his wife and he went to look at the home they just purchased located in the 14000 block of Dahlia Drive. When the Victim entered the home, he could smell of strong odor of what he believed to be marijuana coming from inside the home. The Victim immediately told his wife to exit the home; the Victim then conducted a security check of his home from the outside and discovered the back door of his home kicked in. The Victim called 911, Bowie Police Units arrived on scene at which time two males ran from the home and were apprehended after a brief foot chase. Bowie Police Units then conducted a search of the home and discovered three more males hiding throughout the home. All the subjects were placed into custody and transported to Bowie Police Department for processing and to be interviewed by Bowie Police C.I.D. All were charged. Four of the subjects were transported to Prince Georges County Detention Center for booking. One juvenile subject was transported to Department of Juvenile Justice Facility for processing.

There were no injuries to the victim or the arrested subjects.

All events occurred in the City of Bowie, Prince George’s County, State of Maryland.
