**SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:** On 9/6/2015 at approximately 0050 hours, PFC R. Magnuson was on routine patrol in the 3000 block of Crain Hwy. when he observed a tractor trailer weaving within a lane of travel on Northbound Crain Hwy. PFC Magnuson further observed that the driver was travelling at an extremely low speed, impeding the normal free flow of traffic causing a backup of vehicles behind the tractor trailer. A traffic stop was initiated at the 3500 block of Crain Hwy. and upon speaking with the driver, PFC Magnuson smelled the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. During a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests, the driver displayed signs of intoxication. The driver was placed in handcuffs and agreed to submit to a breathalyzer examination. The driver was transported to PGPD District III where he was able to provide a sufficient breath sample which indicated that he had a blood alcohol content was .14 per 210 liters of breath. The driver was issued citations for Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.
