SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On September 11th, 2015 Bowie CID responded to MPDC Homicide to interview A1 (Dudley) for several burglaries that occurred in The City of Bowie. Dudley waived his rights and confessed to his involvement in the four residential burglaries that are listed above. During the interview Dudley confessed to stealing the red Chrysler 300 from Riverton Ln. and coming back a couple days later and committing the other three burglaries. Dudley was questioned about several other burglaries that occurred on August 12th but denied involvement. Dudley implied that his associates were probably responsible for those set of burglaries but would not identify them. Dudley will be charged accordingly for the four listed burglaries.
