SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On January 6th, 2016, Bowie Police Officers were dispatched to the 3300 block of Superior Lane for a report of a threats complaint. Upon arrival, Officers were met by the reporting person who was in the company of the arrested making threats to do harm to himself and others. The subject threatened to carry out a mass shooting; said he heard voices and was planning on taking out as many people as he could. The subject was arrested and transported to a local hospital for evaluation where he is under a doctor's care. The Federal Bureau of Investigations (Terrorist Watch) Baltimore branch was contacted and notified of the threats complaint. The subject is a juvenile, 15 years of age. He is currently being home-schooled and therefore does not attend public schools. There is no further information at this time.
