SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On 6/19/2016 at approximately 0843 hours, Bowie Police Officers responded to the above location for a commercial robbery. Upon arrival, officers met a store employee, Victim #1, who advised that Suspect #1 entered the store, pressed a screwdriver against his body and demanded merchandise. Suspect #1 fled and jumped into the front passenger seat of a black Honda SUV driven by Suspect #2. Suspect #1 took \$200 cash and 4 cartons of Newport cigarettes. There were no injuries reported. Bowie Police, along with Prince George's County Police, canvassed the area for the suspects with negative results. Prince George's County Police CID Robbery and PGPD Evidence Units responded to process the scene. PGPD CID Robbery will assume this investigation.
