INCIDENT: Theft by Fraud

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On June 26, 2012 at 1840 hrs, Bowie Officers were alerted in reference to a theft by fraud that just occurred. Further investigation revealed that the victim of the apparent fraud was following the suspect. The incident initially occurred in the Best Buy parking lot, which involved a sale of a new IPAD through Craig's List. The victim and suspect agreed to meet at the Bowie Town Center in front of Best Buy to exchange \$ 425.00 for the IPAD. When both the suspect and victim arrived to the location an exchange was completed, and the victim discovered that the IPAD box contained other items minus the IPAD. The suspect fled the location in his vehicle and the victim followed, while notifying the police. Officer Rounds observed the suspect making various traffic violations while attempting to elude the victim that was following. Officer Rounds conducted a car stop on the suspect's vehicle in the area of the 15000 block of Mt. Oak Road. Officer Rounds was notified of the fraud by the victim who witnessed the traffic stop. The suspect was placed under arrest, no injuries occurred in reference to the incident. Bowie CID was notified of the incident and assisted with the investigation.
