League of Women Voters will Host Bowie Candidates Forum on October 15

Bowie voters can learn about candidates and their position on various issues at a **Candidates Forum at the Bowie Center for the Performing Arts on Tuesday, October 15.**

All 22 candidates for City of Bowie offices have been invited to participate in this forum moderated by the Prince George's County League of Women Voters (LWV). This is the first forum to take place after the October 4 filing deadline.

Questions for the candidates will come from the audience and will be submitted at the event before it commences. The LWV will compile the questions and the moderator will pose them to the candidates.

This meeting was moved from the Kenhill Center to the Bowie Center for the Performing Arts to accommodate a larger crowd. Those that cannot attend the forum on the 15th will be able to view it starting October 16 on the City of Bowie television channel.

The event takes place on Tuesday, October 15, from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. Doors will open at 5:30 p.m.
