MARTIN LUTHER KING ART CONTEST WINNERS SELECTED

On Saturday, February 8, 2020, nine local students were named as winners in the City of Bowie Martin Luther King Art Contest. The announcement came during a short program at City Hall honoring Dr. King. Each of the 37 contest finalists was also recognized during the ceremony.

The competition was open to all students living within the municipal boundaries of Bowie or attending a school in the City of Bowie. Kindergarten through second graders colored a picture of Dr. King. Students in grades 3 -5 were tasked with creating a poster that represented the contest theme of “Lifting Our Voices for Freedom.” They were also required to write a short summary explaining their poster. Sixth through twelfth graders were invited to submit a video entry and written description of their video
