



Commercial Burglary

LOCATION: 15600 Emerald Way

LOCATION TYPE: Store Front

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: October 3, 2012 0229hrs

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On October 3, 2012 at 0238hrs, Bowie Officers responded to an alarm call at the location of 15600 Emerald Way, Last Stop clothing store. Upon arrival on scene officers discovered that unknown suspects drove an unregistered mini van through the store front window of the business. Suspects attempted to remove merchandise, such as jackets that were secured by heavy duty security chains with negative results, it is unknown if any additional items were taken. Suspects attempted to flee the location; however the listed vehicle was rendered inoperable because of the heavy front end damage. The suspects later fled in an awaiting vehicle in an unknown direction. An area canvass was conducted with negative results and no injuries were sustained. A Prince George's County Fire Department building assessment officer responded to the location to assess the structure damage of the building.
