INCIDENT: Breaking and Entering Arrest (Residential)

LOCATION: 15200 block of Dalebrooke Drive

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: October 31st, 2012 @ 1920 hours

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On October 31st, 2012 at approximately 1920 hours, Bowie Police Officers responded to a call of service for unknown trouble at a residence in the 15200 block of Dalebrooke Drive. Upon arrival, the Officers that responded met with the Victim and were made aware that three black male juveniles had just broke into the garage of the Victim's residence and stole property, all without the permission of the homeowner. The three suspects fled in an unknown direction. While the Officers were on scene and gathering information, Officers observed an individual that matched the suspect description. The individual was observed carrying the items that were stolen from the residence. The Officers detained the individual and the stolen property was recovered. The Victim's residence was equipped with a home security camera system. Officers observed the recordings of the incident and the individual was identified as one of the three suspects. After reviewing the camera recordings which captured all three suspects, Officers recalled an incident that occurred earlier in the day in which the description of the suspects matched the description of those involved with this incident. Officers were able to link the suspects of the residential burglary to an attempted theft from auto which occurred on Jeremiah Lane. Officers were able to confirm that the suspect was also responsible for this incident. When interviewing the detained suspect, it was learned that the three suspects also stole three bicycles prior to the theft from auto on Jeremiah Lane; the Victim of the stolen bicycles is unknown at this time. Additionally, two of the three suspects were involved in another theft from auto on Dunleigh Court which occurred around the same time as the residential burglary. The detained suspect was then transported to the City of Bowie Police to be processed on charges for the burglary, theft and attempted theft from auto. The detained was then interviewed by the Bowie Police Department's Criminal Investigation Division to determine his involvement in additional cases of theft from autos. The other two suspects are known and charges for the other two suspects involved have been applied for.
