Daily COVID-19 Update for Friday, November 19, 2021

Maryland is reporting that 14.3% of children aged 5-11 years have received the COVID vaccination to date.

Today, the FDA expanded eligibility for COVID boosters to all adults. Following that decision, Governor Hogan ordered all vaccine providers in Maryland to begin administering boosters to anyone age 18 and up. [View press release.](#)

Senior Center Hosts COVID Booster Vaccination Clinic

Also on November 22 from 9 a.m. – noon, Pfizer and Moderna booster shots will be available for individuals ages 65 or older, or age 55 or older with underlying health conditions. Original COVID shot records must be shown and it must be at least six months since your second shot. Shots will be administered by Safeway Pharmacy. If you do not have computer access, the public access computers in the Senior Center lobby can be used to book an appointment. Walk-ins will also be accepted as supplies allow.
