



INCIDENT: DUI Arrest

LOCATION: NB Crain Highway at Pointer Ridge Drive, Bowie, MD 20716

LOCATION TYPE: Street

DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: 09/06/2013 / 0334 Hours

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT: On September 6, 2013 at approximately 0325 hours, PFC Booth #0050 was conducting routine patrol in the 1400 block of Crain Highway in the Pointer Ridge Plaza. PFC Booth observed two vehicles parked at the Sunoco gas station which was closed and unlit. One of these vehicles was a gold Cadillac SLS. PFC Booth approached the vehicles in an attempt to make an investigatory stop when several individuals exited the gold Cadillac. Three of the individuals began walking away from the area on foot and one entered the second vehicle that was in the parking lot. At this point both vehicles began leaving the area. PFC Booth made the decision to follow the Cadillac onto northbound Crain Highway in order to further his investigation. It was at this point that PFC Booth observed that the gold Cadillac's tag lights were not operational. PFC Booth conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle at 0334 hours and made contact with the driver who was identified by his Maryland issued driver's license as Johnathan Ayson Curameng. PFC Booth detected the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from Curameng's breath as he spoke with him. Suspicious that Curameng may be driving under the influence of alcohol, PFC Booth had Curameng exit the vehicle at which point Curameng was subjected to a series of Standardized Field Sobriety Tests which he failed. Curameng was placed under arrest for driving under the influence of alcohol and advised of his right to submit to an alcohol concentration test which he refused. Curameng was then taken to the Bowie Police Station where he was issued multiple traffic citations and released.
