



**INCIDENT: Commercial Armed Robbery**

**LOCATION: 6021 High Bridge Road**

**DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: 02/12/14 2240hrs**

On 02/12/14, Bowie Officers responded to the above location for a commercial armed robbery that just occurred. Upon arrival, employees advised that two suspects, wearing ski masks and dark clothing, entered the gas station. Suspect 1 pointed a handgun at the employee and told him to empty the registers and hand over the money. After both suspects were handed the currency, they fled on foot towards the rear of the business. Prince George's County K-9 CPL. Kehoe #3313, conducted a track along with Bowie Officers which ended in front of a residence on Gulliver's Trail. The snow on the ground showed fresh vehicle tire marks at the end of the track. Prince George's County Police Robbery Detective Paz #3278 responded and will conduct the investigation. An area canvass for possible witnesses and suspects was negative. The Assistant Manager at the location of the incident will attempt to download the surveillance footage of the robbery. There were no injuries reported.
