



INCIDENT: Commercial Armed Robbery (Gun)

SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On 2/22/14 at 1937 hrs, Officers responded to the above location in reference to an armed robbery. The employee on scene reported that two black males drove up on a motorcycle and one came into the store wearing a half helmet and a black mask and displayed a black handgun. Suspect 1 went around the counter demanding the employee to open the register. The employee complied and the suspect grabbed \$300 from the register and placed the money in a bag. Once the suspect had the money, he ran out the store and got on the waiting motorcycle and drove off with suspect #2.

The suspects fled on a black and (gray or red) motorcycle towards Annapolis Road. An area canvass was conducted with negative results.

Prince George's County CID Robbery and Bowie Evidence Unit responded to process scene. There were no injuries reported in reference to this incident.
