



**INCIDENT: PWID Arrest**

**LOCATION: 16519 Governors Bridge Road – Bowie, MD      LOCATION TYPE: Public Street**

**DATE & TIME OF INCIDENT: March 28, 2014 at 2016hrs**

**SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:**

On March 28, 2014 at 2016hrs, Officer Warrington responded to the 16000 block of Governors Bridge Road in reference to an accident. Once on scene, Officer Warrington observed a black Lincoln Town Car smashed against a tree in the rear of the listed location, with the driver (Mr. Simmons-Arrested) still inside of the vehicle. Further investigation with the suspect revealed that he was under the influence of some substance; the driver of the vehicle was very incoherent, combative and confrontational with Officer Warrington. After a brief struggle with Officer Warrington, the suspect was placed under arrest. Upon searching the listed vehicle, Officer Warrington discovered 1 gram of suspected Marijuana, 6 Ecstasy pills, and 1 vial containing 10 grams of suspected PCP, which was located within the suspect's vehicle. The listed items were recovered and submitted to PGC property section and the suspect was transported to DOC for processing. No injuries occurred.
