



**INCIDENT: Robbery**

**LOCATION: 15800 Block Piller Lane - Bowie, MD**

**SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:**

On May 3, 2014 at approximately 1255 hrs, a Bowie Officer on patrol observed an Infiniti sedan being chased by a Jeep Cherokee. When the Officer caught up to both cars, the Jeep Cherokee, being driven by A2 (Jackson, Kerm) began to ram the Infiniti. The Infiniti left the roadway and struck two parked cars at 2300 Mitchellville Road. The Jeep flipped onto its roof, pinning a female passenger by the arm. As the Officer pulled up, A1 (Valentine, Brandon) and an unidentified male passenger, fled on foot from the Infiniti towards Piller Lane. A1 was taken into custody. The passenger made good on his escape.

The investigation revealed that the following events preceded the crash. The driver of the Jeep (A2) and his female passenger had driven from Laurel buy marijuana from an unidentified person. After making contact with his source, four unidentified males approached A2 and said, "Give it up!" One of the males pulled a revolver and A2 fought with him over the gun. The four males continued to assault A2 and his female passenger. During the melee, \$1500 in cash was taken from A2, as was the female's purse. All of the suspects then fled. Two of them got into the blue Infiniti being driven by A1. That is the point at which A2 began to chase the occupants of the Infiniti through the immediate area.

The female passenger of the Cherokee was transported to PGH with significant injuries to her right arm. A1 was charged as an Accessory to Armed Robbery and A2 was charged with First Degree Assault. The revolver was later recovered at the scene of the robbery.
