City Hydrant Flushing Program Delayed Until Summer

Due to the painting of the City's elevated water tank on Belair Drive, the Public Works Department has decided to delay the annual hydrant flushing program for neighborhoods served by City water until summertime.

City officials have determined that if hydrant flushing takes place while the elevated water tank is out of service, there is the possibility of a loss of water pressure in certain City neighborhoods should these events occur simultaneously. Out of an abundance of caution, the annual hydrant flushing program has been postponed until summertime.

The repainting project is expected to take about 90 days to complete. Residents will be notified when flushing is rescheduled for their neighborhoods.
