The Fabulous Hubcaps have been together for 40 years. They play covers of many famous singers and bands, while dressing in costume like the original performers. Attendees can expect songs by Tom Jones, Billy Joel, The Drifters, Benny Goodman, Cher, The Platters, Elvis, Buddy Holly, Tina Turner, Frank Sinatra, Little Richard, the Beach Boys and more during their performances. Matt Corley, Special Events Coordinator for Bowie says of the Fabulous Hubcaps, "They mesmerize audiences with their high energy tributes to amazing artists. We're thrilled to have them with us again this year." The Fabulous Hubcaps were inducted into the Southern Legends Entertainment and Performing Arts Hall of Fame in 2005 and in 2013 the group was inducted into the Maryland Entertainment Hall of Fame.

The Prince George's Stadium is located at 4101 Crain Highway in Bowie. Doors open at 6 p.m. for those who wish to get a prime seat for the concert.
