SYNOPSIS OF INCIDENT:

On 3/21/12 at approximately 0316 hrs, while patrolling in a fully marked police cruiser, Pfc. Booth 050 observed a white 1994 Chevrolet Astro Van leaving the Governor's Green Apartment complex (16400 Block of Governor's Bridge Rd) driving towards Crain highway. The vehicle was noticed to have an inadequately lit rear registration plate, a rear passenger side stop light that was not operating properly, and the vehicle was also noticed to be missing the side mirrors on the both sides of the vehicle. After noticing the violations a traffic stop was initiated. Once PFC Booth approached the vehicle, he noticed there was a strong distinct odor of Marijuana coming out of the driver's side window. During a vehicle search, two large clear zip lock bags and a small green plastic container containing a green leafy substance suspected to marijuana was found. A field test of the substance was conducted provided reaction to the chemical Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC), a chemical known to be found in marijuana. The substance had a gross weight of 19 grams, giving a street value of \$380.00 USD. The arrested was transported to the Department of Corrections and charged accordingly.
