1. Did you know the City of Bowie has a working Sundial? Can you find it?
2. In Centennial Park there is an art piece that shows Bowie’s Past, Present and Future. Can you find it.
3. Did you know that Bowie is the final resting spot of Major Thomas Lansdale who fought in the Continental Army for America’s Independence? Can you find it?
4. Do you know who is considered the Father of Bowie Soccer? There are several fields named for him at Allen Pond Park.
5. Did you know the one of our city parks was once home to two local African-American sandlot baseball teams, the Mitchellville Tigers and the Washington Blacksox. Can you find it?
6. Can you find the third Blues Brother (Statue) located in Old Town Bowie?
7. Can you find the City of Bowie’s Memorial to all her Veterans who have served?
 8. In Bowie we have a Historic Train Caboose. Can you find it?
9. Did you know the City of Bowie has a Memorial Stone to the Late Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. at one of our historic Properties? Can you find it.
10. This building was once the home of Omaha & Gallant Fox the only father and son Triple Crown Winners in Horse Racing. Can you find it?
11. Did you know that there is a Discovery Nature Trail at Whitmarsh Park. Can you find out who it is dedicated to?
12. Did you know Bowie has a Memorial Tree section in one of the parks where many citizens have planted a tree and placed a plaque in remembrance of loved ones. Do you know which park this is?
