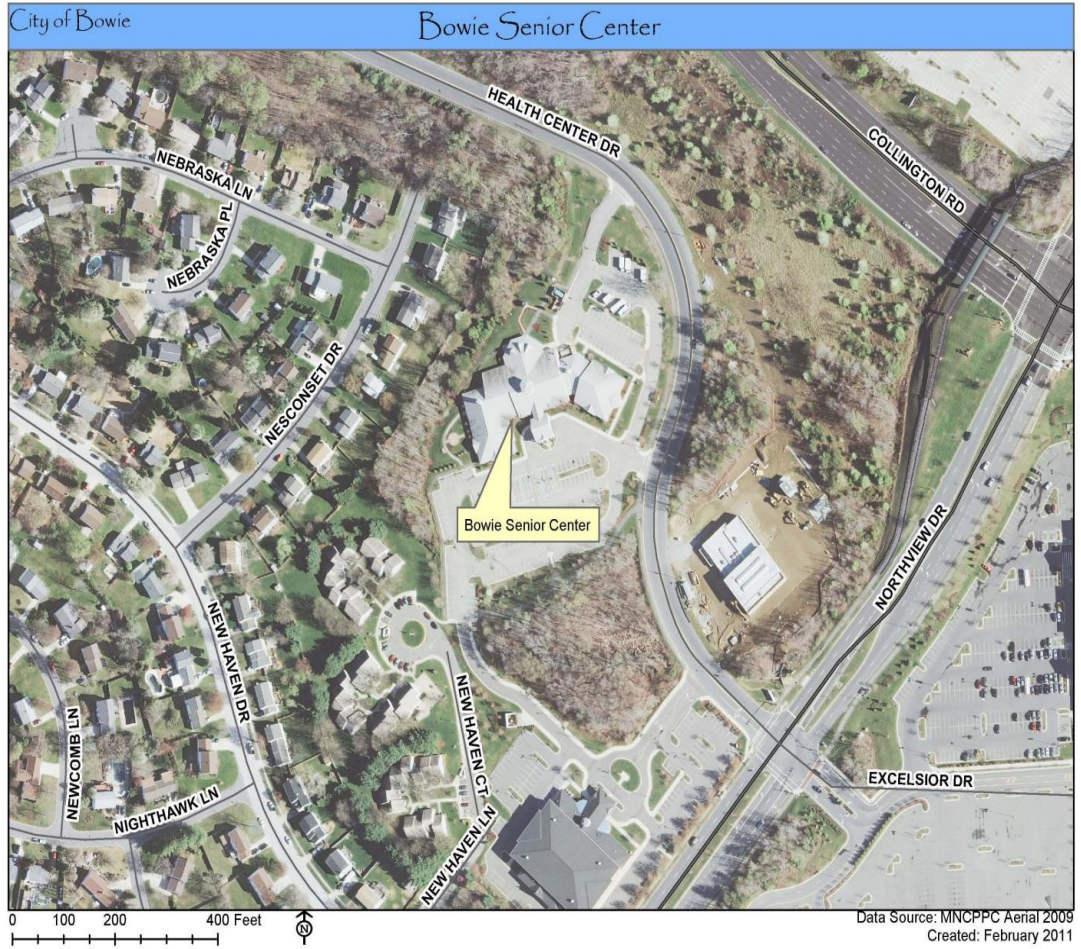


Bowie Senior Center

Background	The Senior Center was built in 2002 and much of the mechanical equipment that provides heat, A/C and ventilation is nearing the end of its life cycle. The City Council has approved a renovation project to update the equipment.
Project Scope	The project includes replacing aged heating, Air conditioning and ventilation equipment. The new equipment will serve all classrooms, offices, exercise rooms, dining room and other common spaces. A new improved efficiency boiler will be installed. The project also includes a modern energy management system
